2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE  
3 CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
4 MODIFYING TITLE 5 OF THE DOUGLAS MUNICIPAL CODE  
5 RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSES AND MOBILE VENDOR  
6 REGULATIONS BY AMENDING PREVIOUS ORDINANCES  
7 PERTAINING TO UNDER CHAPTER 5.02 AND 5.20,  
8 ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY OF COMPONENTS OF  
9 ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE  
10 THEREOF.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as  
12 follows:

13 In order to conform Alarm Business regulations to State law and promote economic revitalization on "G"  
14 Avenue, Title 5, Chapters 5.02 and 5.20, of the Douglas Municipal Code regarding these concepts are hereby  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 SECTION 1. Amending Section 5.02.040 titled Schedule (Paragraph 10):

17 FROM: 10. Alarm, business, alarm agent, solicitor, canvasser, demonstrator and salesman. \$200.00 (per year)

18 TO: 10. Solicitor, canvasser, demonstrator and salesman. \$200.00 (per year)


19 SECTION 2. Amending Section 5.20.030 by eliminating Subsection B-2 and thereby permitting street  
20 vending on "G" Avenue.

21 SECTION 3. All Ordinance and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


22 SECTION 4. Effective date: This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after final approval and  
23 adoption by the Mayor and Council.

24 SECTION 5. Severability: If any chapter, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is  
25 for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction,  
such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance and this Ordinance shall  
continue in full force and effect after the deletion of the illegal or unconstitutional provision.


