

MEDIA RELEASE – Renovations underway at Port of Douglas to make traveling easier

(Douglas, Arizona, January 23, 2020) The commute from Mexico into Douglas, Ariz. will be smoother for travelers in five months as seven primary inspection booths and two commercial truck booths will be renovated.

The Douglas port of entry's cargo dock and exit booths will also face renovations. According to Officer Michael Quinonez of U.S. Customs and Border Protection, not only will the infrastructures be upgraded, but the technology at the port as well. This includes new computers, phone lines, monitors and web service.

Quinonez said if everything works out as it should, the renovations should be done before May. Even with the holidays approaching, U.S. CBP said they have it under control. Quinonez said that CBP is bringing in additional staff to help out during this time of the year.

CBP mentioned that a pedestrian turnstile will be installed along with a handicap accessible entrance.
