RECLAIM YOUR BIKE

Douglas, AZ. February 26, 2020. The Douglas Police Department's abandoned/found bicycle inventory has increased significantly between the years 2013 – 2019. In an effort to return those bicycles back to the rightful owner, Douglas PD is seeking out those that have lost or have had a bicycle stolen (reported or not).

To claim your bike, some documentation with the assigned serial number is preferred. If you do not have that information, a vivid description of the bike (including but not limited to; toe clips, stickers, damages or scratches, special seat, baskets, initials), a picture of the bike, or a sales receipt for when you purchased the bike can help the police identify you as the owner.

In order to ensure the rightful transfer of the property, the information given to reclaim your bicycle will be researched before returning the bike. Those requesting the property will be asked for property identifying information, personal identification and contact information in order to process the request. Copies of all documentation provided, will be taken. The request process can take up to 4 days to conduct the research and return the property.

Requests to reclaim your bicycle can be filled out at the Douglas Police Department at 300 W 14th Street. Bicycles not claimed after thirty (30) calendar days of this notice will be subject to sale, donation or destruction (A.R.S 12-942).
