# Crime Prevention and Safety



## Secure your Vehicle

- ◇ Secure your windows and vehicle doors.
- ◇ Keep all valuables out of vehicles.
- ◇ Use a steering wheel lock and set the alarm.



## Safe Travels

- ◆ When Traveling, remember to avoid driving when fatigued.
- ◆ Make sure your tires are properly inflated.
- ◆ Try to Keep your gas tank at minimum of half full to avoid gas line freeze-up.
- ◆ In cold, rainy and snowy weather try to avoid using your parking break.
- ◆ Cruise control can be dangerous when driving on any slippery surface (wet, ice, sand).
- ◆ Keep your eyes on the road.
- ◆ Always use your seatbelt

## Protect Your Home

- When outside the home, make sure all windows and doors are secured.
- Use a dowel in the lower track of windows and patio doors.
- Keep all exterior doors locked.
- Secure doggie doors whenever possible.
- Keep curtains closed at night and when away.
- Leave a radio or TV on near exterior doors.
- When out of town, contact the Douglas Police Department to be placed on extra patrol.
