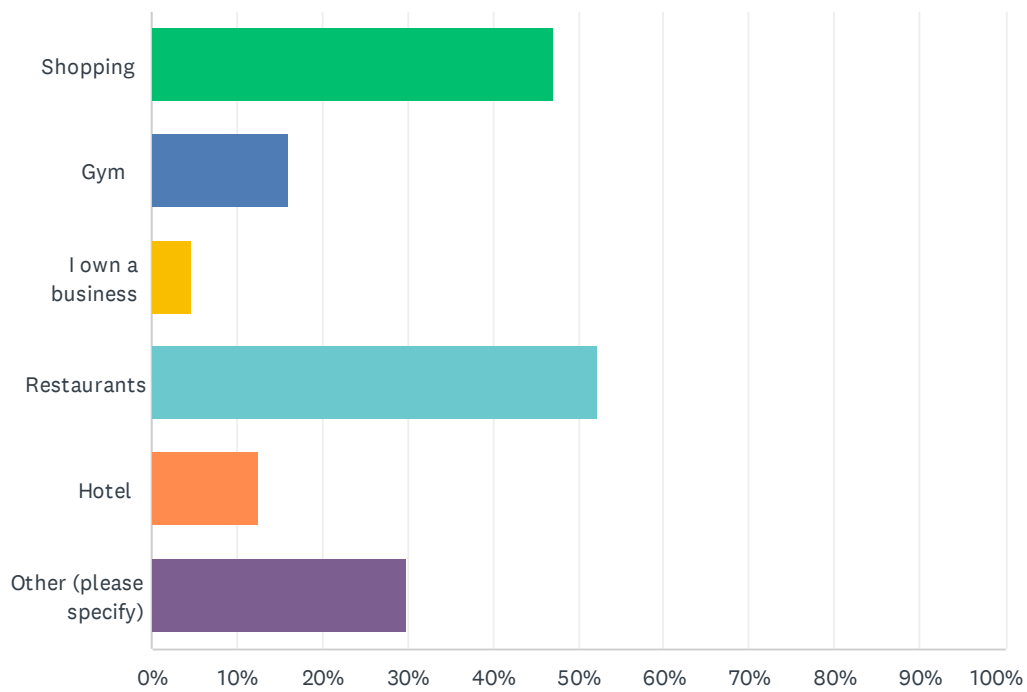


Q1 What currently brings you to the downtown area?

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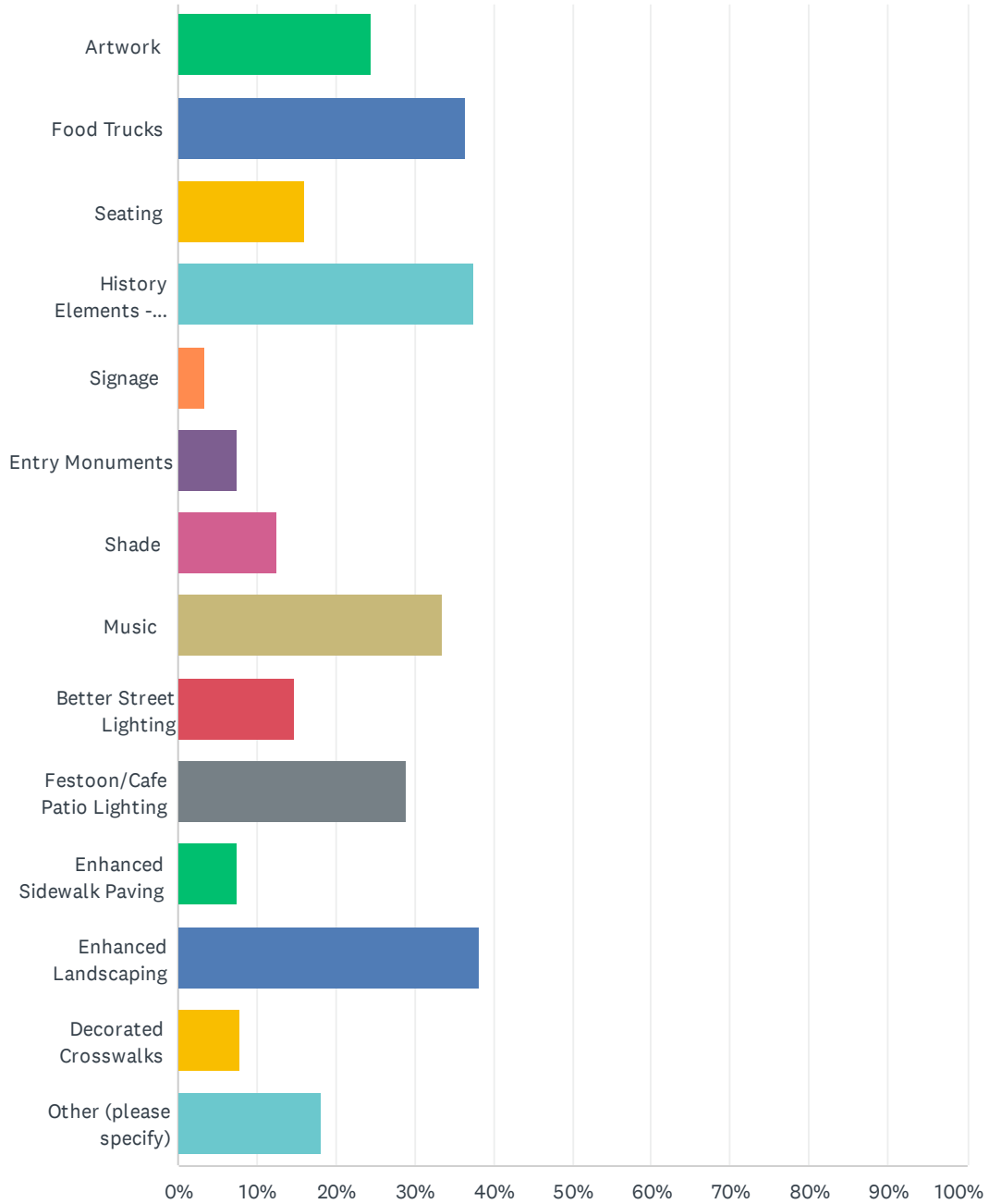
